# **The LNM Institute of Information Technology, Jaipur**

*(Deemed University)*

Agenda Item: To discuss Academic year 2009-10 undergraduate admissions.

a) Admissions -2009

The Academic Council noted the Communication received from Central Counseling Board (CCB) which stipulated that there will be 5<sup>th</sup> and subsequent round of counseling of fill-up vacant seats and that the said counseling will take place after CCB has collected information from all participating Institutes regarding the students, who report and opt for the 5<sup>th</sup> round.

The Academic Council further noted the expected date of announcement of 5<sup>th</sup> round of counseling and subsequent reporting would be 5<sup>th</sup> August onwards and 10<sup>th</sup> August onwards respectively.


The Academic Council observed that 5<sup>th</sup> round of counseling was optional for both students and participating Institute and expressed the view that in the interest of quality, admissions cannot be delayed till 2<sup>nd</sup> week of August. The council desired that Institute should withdraw from 5<sup>th</sup> round of counseling after seeking approval from CCB. In order to off-set revenue loss, as a consequence of this decision, the Academic council decided that the Institute should offer admissions to students who have received the IIT-JEE rank better then the closing AIEEE Rank and all such admissions through JEE route should be completed by August 02, 2009.

b) Lateral entry Cases


The Academic Council considered the request for direct admission received from Ms. Aditi Sharma and Ms. Surabhi Kumari Choudhary.

The Academic Council did not find merit in allowing them seek admission in the Institute on the ground that All India Rank of applicants in such cases should be close to our admission closing rank.
