The Academic Council unanimously decided as under:

- a) In view of the steady progress shown by Mr. G Ruthvik Reddy, Roll No. Y10UC111, he is allowed to continue his academic programme. He will now onwards be governed by the rules applicable to Academically Deficient Students. Further, he is now placed on disciplinary probation for the entire duration of his undergraduate programme in the Institute.
- b) With his extremely poor academic record in the Institute so far, Mr. B. Likith Singh, Roll No. Y09UC225 be not permitted to continue his academic programme in the institute any longer. His appeal was rejected and hence his academic programme stands terminated, as per the earlier decision of the Academic Council.
- c) In view of the inadequate time available to Mr. Amit Raj, Roll No. Y10UC023 and Mr. Anurag Sharma, Roll No. Y10UC070, to meet the stipulated academic standard and the marginal deficiency in their CPI, the Academic Council decided to allow them to continue their academic programmes. They will now onwards be governed according to the rules governing the Academically Deficient Students. Besides, they will continue to


remain on Disciplinary Probation for the entire duration of their undergraduate programme in the Institute.

Arising out of the discussion, the Chairman observed that quite a large number of undergraduate students are not able to meet their academic requirements and this aspect needs to be analyzed objectively. In this respect, it was also emphasized that all rules/policies framed by the Academic Council from time to time be implemented.

It was emphasized that the academic management of deficient students is needed and as such all concerned should pay attention to this aspect.

The Chairman ruled that copies of the confirmed minutes of the Academic Council be kept in the library.

Thereafter, the meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
