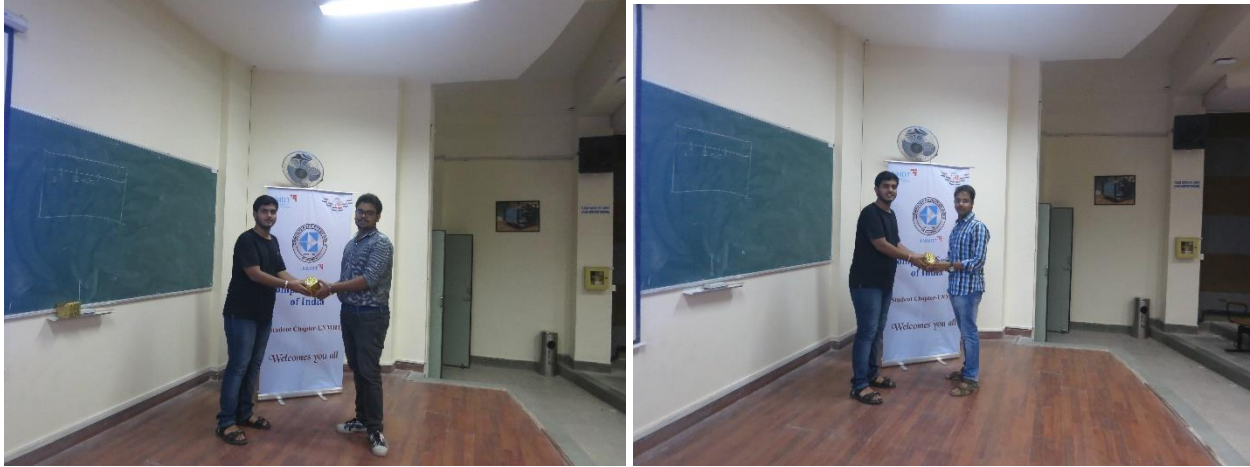
## Event Report – Workshop On R
